



To use Westmeath County Library's Wi-fi

1. You must be a current member of the Library.
2. Present your Library membership card at the desk where you will be issued a **PIN**. This will allow you to connect to the WiFi.
3. If you are **Under 18** (Child protection guidelines) your WiFi use must be authorised by a parent/guardian. The internet permission form be filled in and signed at the Information Desk by your parent/guardian. Parents and Guardians are responsible for their children's internet usage.
4. You may **print** from your device to the library printer. Printing costs 25c per black and white A4 copy and €1 per colour A4 copy.
5. You must not obstruct the work of other library users and/or staff. Please ensure that power cables etc. do not become a trip hazard. Please note that there may be more users than power sockets available; the charging of your device is your responsibility.
6. You should refer to your to your device's manual for help in configuring your settings. Library staff cannot assist in trouble-shooting as every device is different.
7. Please remember that on occasion the WiFi service may be unavailable due to technical reasons that are beyond the control of library staff.
8. Unauthorised use of the WiFi and Internet service is prohibited. This includes:
 - a. Accessing material which is deemed obscene
 - b. Attempting to violate system security, including interference with network and databases.
 - c. Any activity which breaches current legislation including copyright law.Any person involved in unauthorised use and who does not abide by the guidelines will have their access to the service withdrawn.
